China has been Indonesia's largest trading partner for 9 years and Indonesia's largest export destination country for

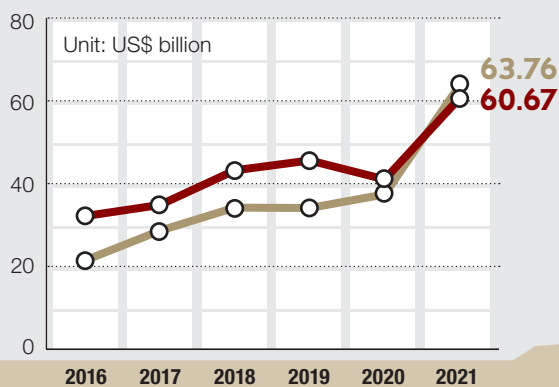

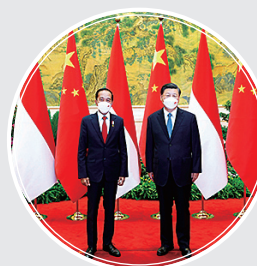
